THE SITUATION

- At this very moment, more than 800 million people are starving.
- Every 3.6 seconds, someone dies of starvation, a result of living in dire poverty. Usually, it is a child under the age of five.
- In the next seven seconds, another hungry child under five will die.
- Worldwide, 1 in 4 children don't get the nutrition they need.
- Over 9 million people die worldwide each year because of hunger and malnutrition. Between five and six million of them are children. This means that on any given day, hunger is the main cause of death for about 25,000 people.
- Approximately 1.2 billion people suffer from hunger (deficiency of calories and protein).
- Some 2 to 3.5 billion people have micronutrient deficiency (deficiency of vitamins and minerals).

PROJECT DESCTRIPTION

Through this initiative we focus on feeding children in community schools we work with where most of the children rely on the school's provision as their only source of food for the day. Other times we focus on providing assistance and food to orphans that truly need help. That means we seek out those orphan care programs that have exhibited the ability and history to care effectively for the needs of orphans; yet struggle to provide the necessary food. Our primary objective is to ensure that the target beneficiaries have access to sufficient food and nutrient intake for physical growth, cognitive development, and general wellbeing. \$15 can provide a month's worth of school meals for a child.

PROGRAM BENEFITS

- School children will have access to good and quality food.
- Increase in school enrollment and attendance.
- Increased cognitive development, concentration and assimilation of children in class.
- Parents and caregivers of these children will save money meant for the children's school meal and use it for other expenses in the home.
- End malnutrition among school children by providing nutritious meals.
