THE SITUATION

Around the world, millions of children are growing up without the care, protection, and stability of a loving family. Each day brings uncertainty, where the next meal is not guaranteed, shelter is temporary at best, and the warmth of a caring embrace is a distant memory or an unknown experience. Without intervention, these children remain caught in cycles of despair, with little opportunity to grow, dream, or thrive.
